The Department of Agriculture, Food and the Marine require, under the Statutory Instrument Control on Places where Horses are Kept Regulations 2014 (S.I. No 113 of 2014), that anyone who is the owner/person in charge of any premises in which horses or other equines (such as donkeys, ponies etc) are kept register their Equine premises with the Department and receive their Equine Premises Number.

Equine Premises is any premises (with or without land) in which a horse, ass, mule, pony, donkey etc. is kept either on a full-time 'permanent' basis (farms etc) or an enterprise (such as shows, sales, gymkhanas, racecourses, hunts, veterinary hospitals, farriers, pounds, studs, fairs etc) to/from which equine movements take place.
