### IRISH HORSERACING REGULATORY BOARD

The Directors of the IHRB, at their Board Meeting on 5 March 2025 approved the following changes to Rule 298 which will become effective on 6 March 2025:

#### Part XXIX

#### STABLE EMPLOYEES BONUS SCHEME

#### 298 (i) - (xi) [TEXT DELETED]

- . Trainers shall make an agreement with registered stable staff on an annual basis in compliance with the HRI Stable Employee Bonus Scheme (SEBS) Guidelines (the "Agreement"). This Agreement must include the date of the meeting, how the monies provided under the SEBS are to be distributed including any individuals or categories of staff who are to be omitted from distribution and be signed in accordance with the SEBS Guidance.
- A copy of the signed Agreement must be lodged with the Office of the IHRB within seven days of signing or when requested by IHRB.
- A completed copy of the Agreement must be permanently displayed in a communal area where all staff working at the Trainer's premises can view the agreement.
- 4. Monies must be distributed in accordance with the Stable Employee Bonus Scheme (SEBS) Guidelines and with the Agreement.
- 5. Trainers shall make a written declaration that payment has been made in accordance with the Agreement within fourteen days of a request from the IHRB. The declaration must include details of any deviation from or alternation of the terms of the Agreement.
- Submission of false, inaccurate, or misleading information, or failure to comply with any obligation under this Rule, shall constitute a breach and may be subject to disciplinary action under the Rules.

### IRISH HORSERACING REGULATORY BOARD

The Directors of the IHRB, at their Board Meeting on 5 March 2025 approved the following changes to Rule 20 (xxiii) which will become effective on 6 March 2025:

PROPOSED RULE ON MEDIA: RULE 20 (xxiii)

#### [Insert within Powers of Directors]

- (a) The Directors of the IHRB shall have the authority to regulate and oversee media attendance at hearings. They may establish rules governing media access, conduct, and reporting to ensure compliance with IHRB Standards, Protocols, and Guidelines. The Directors also have the power to restrict or prohibit media attendance if deemed necessary in the interest of fairness, confidentiality, or the integrity of proceedings.
- (b) Representatives of the media attending hearings must comply with the Guidelines and any instructions issued by the IHRB, the Chairperson, or Directors.
- (c) Hearings of the Referrals Committee or Appeals Body shall be open to media representatives unless the Chairperson directs otherwise. When attending a hearing, the media must respect all instructions and notices as issued by the IHRB, the Chairperson or Directors. The Chairperson may also impose restrictions on the publication of certain matters arising during the hearing.
- (d) The deliberations of Disciplinary Panels shall be conducted in private.
- (e) All hearings shall be recorded by the IHRB, and such recordings shall remain confidential and be the sole property of the IHRB.
- (f) Transcripts of these recordings shall not be made public. No person shall have the right to access or compel the production of a recording, copy, or transcript except where required by law, if they are an interested party, and upon payment of the relevant administrative fee.

Having viewed a recording of the race and considered the evidence, the Acting Stewards were of the opinion that the rider was in breach of Regulation 58. 3.(h) in that he had used the whip with his arm being or appearing to be above shoulder height. Having taken his previous record into consideration, the Acting Stewards suspended Mr S. Cavanagh for one Point to Point raceday.

Horses and those in charge of them are received on the terms that the Executive and the Stewards of the respective Meetings are not to be liable for any damage, loss or injury to such horses or persons while in or about the stabling or on the Course from any cause whatsoever.

Nominations can only be made and accepted on the condition that the nominator subjects himself/herself, in all respects to the Rules & HRI Directives under which each race is run. Races and divisions are run subject to the provisions of Rule 20.

Handicap races closing under the Irish entry system will be calculated at the time of closing. The rating qualification will take into account all performances up to and including the **Sunday** previous to the rating qualification date.

In accordance with Rule 101 (iv), the Qualifying Ratings shall be calculated on each Monday at 12 noon. The Qualifying Rating for each horse shall be equivalent to the horse's current Rating at that time.

#### **Qualifying Ratings For Flat Races**

For the purposes of qualification for flat handicaps, in the event of a horse being assigned a separate handicap mark for "all weather" handicaps, the "all weather" qualification rating will be the horse's qualifying rating for "all weather" racing. In the event of a horse being assigned only one handicap rating, the same qualifying rating shall apply for qualification purposes to handicaps run on both turf and "all weather" surfaces.

#### **Entries & Declarations**

Entries for horses trained outside of Ireland must be made through the relevant Turf Authority and close by 11am on the same day they close with Horse Racing Ireland. Entries for early closing races are accepted through the relevant Turf Authorities on the same day they close with Horse Racing Ireland at 12 noon.

**049E** Holden Plant Rentals Shamrock H'cap S'chase The IHRB Veterinary Officer examined One Last Tango, trained by Eoin Griffin, at the request of the Raceday Stewards and reported the animal to have been struck into on his right hind leg but was otherwise found to be postrace normal.

The IHRB Veterinary Officer examined Hands Of Gold, trained by A.L.T. Moore, at the request of the Raceday Stewards and reported the animal to have been struck into on his left hind leg and to have lost the left hind shoe, but was otherwise found to be post-race normal.

M.P. Walsh, rider of One Last Tango, trained by Eoin Griffin, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount lost his action.

**049F INHSC Tetratema Cup Hunters S'chase** The IHRB Veterinary Officer examined Annamix (FR), trained by W.P. Mullins, at the request of

the Raceday Stewards and reported the animal to be post-race normal.

The IHRB Veterinary Officer examined Big Interest, trained by D.M. Christie, at the request of the Raceday Stewards and reported the animal to have lost his right front shoe, but was otherwise found to be post-race normal.

The IHRB Veterinary Officer examined Early Doors (FR), trained by E. Bolger, at the request of the Raceday Stewards and reported the animal to have lost a left front shoe, but was otherwise found to be post-race normal.

The Raceday Stewards interviewed Mr B.T. Stone, rider of Step Up Son, concerning his use of the whip in the closing stages of this race. Evidence was heard from the rider concerned, who accepted that he had failed to give his mount sufficient time to respond to the whip between strikes. Having viewed a recording of the race and considered the evidence, the Raceday Stewards found Mr Stone to have been in breach of Regulation 10.3.(i) (time to respond). Having considered his clean record in this regard, they suspended him for two racedays.

**050B** Bar One Racing Kingsfurze Novice H'dle The IHRB Veterinary Officer examined Pleasington, trained by Olly Murphy (in GB), at the request of the Raceday Stewards and reported the animal to have lost his left fore shoe but was otherwise found to be post-race normal.

The IHRB Veterinary Officer examined Belloccio (FR), trained by W.P. Mullins, at the request of the Raceday Stewards and reported the animal to be post-race normal.

**050C** Bar One Racing Price Boosts H'cap H'dle The Raceday Stewards interviewed O.R. Brown, rider of Simply Shabra, concerning his riding on the rider's first approach to the Starter. Evidence was heard from the rider concerned who stated that his mount broke into a canter and is a hard horse to take back as he has a very big stride. Having considered the evidence, the Raceday Stewards were satisfied that O.R. Brown was in breach of Rule 208(iii)(b) in that he had put his mount into a trot or canter with a view to taking an advantage

before the race was started. Having taken his record into account (second offence), the Raceday Stewards suspended O.R. Brown for two racedays.

At the request of the Raceday Stewards, P. Byrnes, rider of Comanche Moon, trained by C. Byrnes, reported to the Stewards' Secretaries that he ended up further back than he wanted as a result of the false start and then was impeded by the faller at the last flight of hurdles. R.A. Doyle, rider of It's Never Simple, trained by Martin Brassil, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount a mistake at the second last hurdle.

050D Bar One Racing Extra Place H'cap H'dle The Raceday Stewards granted a request from Hugh Paul Finegan, trainer of Lady Bluebird, for an additional ten minutes to present his charge for identification by an IHRB Official in accordance with the provisions of Rule 90(i). The Raceday Stewards subsequently ordered the withdrawal of Lady Bluebird as the animal failed to present at the newly approved time.

The Raceday Stewards reviewed the rider's first approach to the Starter where it appeared American Money, ridden by Cian Cullinan, broke into a canter before the Starter had dropped his flag. Having viewed the recording of the incident, the Raceday Stewards were satisfied that American Money had broken into a canter despite his rider's best efforts and that no further action was warranted.

The IHRB Veterinary Officer examined Duke Of Leggagh, trained by Michael Mulvany, at the request of the Raceday Stewards and reported the animal to have lost a left fore shoe but was otherwise found to be post-race normal.

The IHRB Veterinary Officer examined Uhavemeinstitches, trained by J. Motherway, at the request of the Raceday Stewards and reported the animal to have slightly moved a right hind shoe but was otherwise found to be post-race normal.

P.M. O'Brien, rider of Duke Of Leggagh, trained by Michael Mulvany, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount ran flat.

S.D. Torrens, rider of Uhavemeinstitches, trained by J. Motherway, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount lost her action and was subsequently pulled up.

050F Bar One Racing Leinster National H'cap S'chase The Raceday Stewards requested a report from Oliver McKiernan, trainer, as to the apparent improvement in form of Bushmans Pass, placed first, as compared with his recent form when pulling up at Punchestown on 20th February. Mr. McKieran stated that his charge missed the break on his previous start and ended up further back than ideal and then made a bad mistake and was subsequently pulled up. He further added that his charge appreciated today's drying ground conditions and the application of first time cheekpieces. Having considered the report, the Raceday Stewards noted its content.

The IHRB Veterinary Officer examined Tyre Kicker (FR), trained by Gavin Cromwell, at the request of the Raceday Stewards and reported the animal to be coughing and he was also found to be lame.

The Raceday Stewards reviewed the riders' first and second approach to the Starter, where the riders were instructed to go back and take a turn on both occasions. Having reviewed the matter and consulted with the Senior Starter, Mr. J.R. Banahan, the Raceday Stewards were satisfied that the instruction to go back was for good reason and they were also satisfied that no riding offence had occurred.
