## IRISH HORSERACING REGULATORY BOARD

The Directors of the IHRB, at their Board Meeting on 5 March 2025 approved the following changes to Rule 298 which will become effective on 6 March 2025:

### Part XXIX

#### STABLE EMPLOYEES BONUS SCHEME

##### 298 (i) – (xi) [TEXT DELETED]

- Trainers shall make an agreement with registered stable staff on an annual basis in compliance with the HRI Stable Employee Bonus Scheme (SEBS) Guidelines (the "Agreement"). This Agreement must include the date of the meeting, how the monies provided under the SEBS are to be distributed including any individuals or categories of staff who are to be omitted from distribution and be signed in accordance with the SEBS Guidance.
- A copy of the signed Agreement must be lodged with the Office of the IHRB within seven days of signing or when requested by IHRB.
- A completed copy of the Agreement must be permanently displayed in a communal area where all staff working at the Trainer's premises can view the agreement.
- Monies must be distributed in accordance with the Stable Employee Bonus Scheme (SEBS) Guidelines and with the Agreement.
- Trainers shall make a written declaration that payment has been made in accordance with the Agreement within fourteen days of a request from the IHRB. The declaration must include details of any deviation from or alternation of the terms of the Agreement.
- Submission of false, inaccurate, or misleading information, or failure to comply with any obligation under this Rule, shall constitute a breach and may be subject to disciplinary action under the Rules.

## IRISH HORSERACING REGULATORY BOARD

The Directors of the IHRB, at their Board Meeting on 5 March 2025 approved the following changes to Rule 20 (xxiii) which will become effective on 6 March 2025:

### PROPOSED RULE ON MEDIA: RULE 20 (xxiii)

#### [Insert within Powers of Directors]

- The Directors of the IHRB shall have the authority to regulate and oversee media attendance at hearings. They may establish rules governing media access, conduct, and reporting to ensure compliance with IHRB Standards, Protocols, and Guidelines. The Directors also have the power to restrict or prohibit media attendance if deemed necessary in the interest of fairness, confidentiality, or the integrity of proceedings.
- Representatives of the media attending hearings must comply with the Guidelines and any instructions issued by the IHRB, the Chairperson, or Directors.
- Hearings of the Referrals Committee or Appeals Body shall be open to media representatives unless the Chairperson directs otherwise. When attending a hearing, the media must respect all instructions and notices as issued by the IHRB, the Chairperson or Directors. The Chairperson may also impose restrictions on the publication of certain matters arising during the hearing.
- The deliberations of Disciplinary Panels shall be conducted in private.
- All hearings shall be recorded by the IHRB, and such recordings shall remain confidential and be the sole property of the IHRB.
- Transcripts of these recordings shall not be made public. No person shall have the right to access or compel the production of a recording, copy, or transcript except where required by law, if they are an interested party, and upon payment of the relevant administrative fee.

**STANDARD CONDITIONS**

The Racing Calendar Office of Weatherbys Thoroughbred Ltd. receives entries submitted for acceptance as agents for the Racecourse Authority and only upon the terms of the Standard Conditions. Acceptance of entries is subject to the power to refuse to allow entries to be accepted conferred by the Orders and Rules of Racing on the British Horseracing Authority Ltd. Entries are accepted by the Racing Calendar Office, acting as aforesaid, causing the name of the horse in question to be published as being entered for the race in question either in The Racing Calendar, when the race closes more than six days before running, or, for other races, on the British Horseracing Authority Racing Administration Internet site ([www.racingadmin.co.uk](http://www.racingadmin.co.uk)) and ordinarily in the Sporting Press.

**FRANCE** - Owners and trainers of horses trained outside of France are reminded that, to enter any horse in a French race for the first time, they must register their horses in training through their access online at least 8 days before the closing time of entry, with the correct name of the horse, its suffix, sex, year of foaling and pedigree (sire, dam and sire of dam).

This declaration is not considered as an entry. Trainers are to make their entries and other declarations directly online. They must also supply a complete race record of all the performances of the horse(s) entered on the Internet, by fax (33 1 47 61 93 37) or email ([fgperf@france-galop.com](mailto:fgperf@france-galop.com)). The entry will not be valid if these performances are not received by the international department at Racing Operations by the time of the first forfeit, or on the eve of the declaration to run (if entries were made more than a month before the race). When declaring a horse to run, it is the responsibility of the trainer to check the weight carried.

In the event of a horse being assigned only one handicap rating, the same qualifying rating shall apply for qualification purposes to handicaps run on both turf and "all weather" surfaces.

O'Connor, placed third, and Amemri (GB), ridden by L.T. McAteer, placed first, where it appeared interference may have occurred. Evidence was heard from the riders concerned. D.J. O'Connor stated that he thought Amemri was clear of him and they both went right. L.T. McAteer stated that his mount drifted right but he corrected her straightaway. He further added he was clear of Superior Force. Having viewed the recording of the race and considered the evidence, the Raceday Stewards made no alteration to the Judge's placings and were satisfied that no further action was warranted. D.J. O'Connor was accompanied by Kevin Borthwick at this enquiry.

J. Kearney, rider of Pink Oxalis, trained by Stephen Thorne, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount went right inside the last 200 yards.

L.T. McAteer, rider of Amemri (GB), trained by David Marnane, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount ran around in front.

C.D. Hayes, rider of Royal Tribute, trained by John C. McConnell, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount was very slowly away.

**048C Floodlit Friday Nights At Dundalk H'cap** The Raceday Stewards enquired into possible interference in the closing stages of this race involving Velvet Skies, ridden by W.J. Lee, placed first, and Rattletheonionbag, ridden by C.D. Hayes, placed second, where it appeared interference may have occurred. Evidence was heard from the riders concerned. C.D. Hayes stated that the two horses met each other 75 yards out and that his filly was smaller

than Velvet Skies and she became unbalanced. W.J. Lee stated that he kept a straight line and received a bump which turned his mount into Rattletheonionbag. Having viewed the recording of the race and considered the evidence, the Raceday Stewards made no alteration to the Judge's placings and were satisfied that no further action was warranted. J. Kearney, rider of Dream Today, trained by Stephen Thorne, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount was keen early on.

W.J. Lee, rider of Velvet Skies, trained by Michael Mulvany, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount received a slight bump 80 yards out.

C.D. Hayes, rider of Rattletheonionbag, trained by W.P. Browne, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount received a bump from the winner 75 yards out.

**048D Cheltenham Live On Racing TV (Q.R.) H'cap** The IHRB Veterinary Officer examined Beauforts Storm, trained by Timothy Doyle, at the request of the Raceday Stewards and reported the animal to be post-race normal.

**048E DundalkStadium.com Apprentice H'cap** The Raceday Stewards fined John C. McConnell, trainer, €65 for failing to fit the declared visor to Slowdownbarney, prior to entering the parade ring.

S. Coen, rider of Slowdownbarney, trained by John C. McConnell, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount leaned right in the final furlong.

P.A. Harnett, rider of Rock Basher, trained by Shane Crawley, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount was too free all the way. J. Pietropaolo, rider of Tastyee, trained by David Kenneth Budds, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount hung badly right up the straight.

**048G William Hill Top Price Guarantee Patton Race** The IHRB Veterinary Officer examined Mount Kilimanjaro (FR), trained by A.P. O'Brien, at the request of the Raceday Stewards and reported the animal to be post-race normal.

**048H William Hill Proper Pricing H'cap** The Raceday Stewards fined Daniel James Murphy, trainer, €65 for failing to fit the declared blinkers to Tribal Moon, prior to entering the parade ring.

**049A Golf Classics At Gowran Park M'dn H'dle** Prior to the running of this race, A.J. Martin, trainer of Zuzukel (FR), reported to the Stewards' Secretaries that his charge is a very difficult individual who would be leaving the parade ring last and wearing a red hood to the start. He advised that in order for his charge to

be seen to be running to his best effect in the race, he would be instructing his rider to jump off a few lengths behind the other runners, in order to get his mount to settle and to ride his race from there. He was strongly of the view that a failure to use these tactics would result in his charge running too freely and being uncompetitive.

D. King, rider of Zuzukel (FR), trained by A.J. Martin, reported to the Stewards' Secretaries that his mount was difficult to settle, jumped poorly and found nothing in the closing stages.

**049B Lord Bagenal Hotel (Mares) M'dn H'dle** The IHRB Veterinary Officer examined Neon Diamond, trained by Gordon Elliott, at the request of the Raceday Stewards and reported the animal to be post-race normal.

The Raceday Stewards interviewed Mr D.L. Queally, rider of Long Gone, concerning his riding on the rider's first approach to the Starter. Evidence was heard from the rider concerned who stated that his charge is a very difficult ride, a front runner and that he was mindful that there was a horse being led in and he did his best to control his mount. Having considered the evidence, the Raceday Stewards were satisfied that Mr Queally was in breach of Rule 208 (iii)(b) in that he had put his mount into a trot or canter with a view to taking an advantage before the race was started. Having taken his clean record in this regard into account, the Raceday Stewards suspended him for one raceday.

A representative of M.F. Morris, trainer of Miss Corby, reported to the Stewards' Secretaries (via the IHRB Veterinary Officer) that his charge was showing signs of being in season post-race.

J.W. Kennedy, rider of Neon Diamond, trained by Gordon Elliott, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount hung left and was pulled up.

**049C HPR Fleet Management H'cap H'dle** The IHRB Veterinary Officer examined Love Me (FR), trained by Henry de Bromhead, at the request of the Raceday Stewards and reported the animal to be post-race normal.

**049D BoyleSports Money Back H'cap H'dle** Mr C.J. Shine, rider of Knockbrack Rambler, trained by Brendan Maurice Walsh, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount made a bad mistake at the sixth last hurdle.

**049E Holden Plant Rentals Shamrock H'cap S'chase** The IHRB Veterinary Officer examined One Last Tango, trained by Eoin Griffin, at the request of the Raceday Stewards and reported the animal to have been struck into on his right hind leg but was otherwise found to be post-race normal.

The IHRB Veterinary Officer examined Hands Of Gold, trained by A.L.T. Moore, at the request of the Raceday Stewards and reported the animal to have been struck into on his left hind leg and to have lost the left hind shoe, but was otherwise found to be post-race normal.

M.P. Walsh, rider of One Last Tango, trained by Eoin Griffin, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount lost his action.

**049F INHSC Tetratema Cup Hunters S'chase** The IHRB Veterinary Officer examined Annamix (FR), trained by W.P. Mullins, at the request of

the Raceday Stewards and reported the animal to be post-race normal.

The IHRB Veterinary Officer examined Big Interest, trained by D.M. Christie, at the request of the Raceday Stewards and reported the animal to have lost his right front shoe, but was otherwise found to be post-race normal.

The IHRB Veterinary Officer examined Early Doors (FR), trained by E. Bolger, at the request of the Raceday Stewards and reported the animal to have lost a left front shoe, but was otherwise found to be post-race normal.

The Raceday Stewards interviewed Mr B.T. Stone, rider of Step Up Son, concerning his use of the whip in the closing stages of this race. The IHRB Veterinary Officer examined Bellocchio (FR), trained by W.P. Mullins, at the request of the Raceday Stewards and reported the animal to be post-race normal.

**050C Bar One Racing Price Boosts H'cap H'dle** The Raceday Stewards interviewed O.R. Brown, rider of Simply Shabra, concerning his riding on the rider's first approach to the Starter. Evidence was heard from the rider concerned who stated that his mount broke into a canter and is a hard horse to take back as he has a very big stride. Having considered the evidence, the Raceday Stewards were satisfied that O.R. Brown was in breach of Rule 208(iii)(b) in that he had put his mount into a trot or canter with a view to taking an advantage

before the race was started. Having taken his record into account (second offence), the Raceday Stewards suspended O.R. Brown for two racedays.

At the request of the Raceday Stewards, P. Byrnes, rider of Comanche Moon, trained by C. Byrnes, reported to the Stewards' Secretaries that he ended up further back than he wanted as a result of the false start and then was impeded by the faller at the last flight of hurdles. R.A. Doyle, rider of It's Never Simple, trained by Martin Brassil, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount a mistake at the second last hurdle.

**050D Bar One Racing Extra Place H'cap H'dle** The Raceday Stewards granted a request from Hugh Paul Finegan, trainer of Lady Bluebird, for an additional ten minutes to present his charge for identification by an IHRB Official in accordance with the provisions of Rule 90(i). The Raceday Stewards subsequently ordered the withdrawal of Lady Bluebird as the animal failed to present at the newly approved time.

The Raceday Stewards reviewed the rider's first approach to the Starter where it appeared American Money, ridden by Cian Cullinan, broke into a canter before the Starter had dropped his flag. Having viewed the recording of the incident, the Raceday Stewards were satisfied that American Money had broken into a canter despite his rider's best efforts and that no further action was warranted.

The IHRB Veterinary Officer examined Duke Of Leggagh, trained by Michael Mulvany, at the request of the Raceday Stewards and reported the animal to have lost a left fore shoe but was otherwise found to be post-race normal.

The IHRB Veterinary Officer examined Uhavemeinstiches, trained by J. Motherway, at the request of the Raceday Stewards and reported the animal to have slightly moved a right hind shoe but was otherwise found to be post-race normal.

P.M. O'Brien, rider of Duke Of Leggagh, trained by Michael Mulvany, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount ran flat.

S.D. Torrens, rider of Uhavemeinstiches, trained by J. Motherway, reported to the Clerk of the Scales that his mount lost her action and was subsequently pulled up.

**050F Bar One Racing Leinster National H'cap S'chase** The Raceday Stewards requested a report from Oliver McKiernan, trainer, as to the apparent improvement in form of Bushmans Pass, placed first, as compared with his recent form when pulling up at Punchestown on 20th February. Mr. McKiernan stated that his charge missed the break on his previous start and ended up further back than ideal and then made a bad mistake and was subsequently pulled up. He further added that his charge appreciated today's drying ground conditions and the application of first time cheekpieces. Having considered the report, the Raceday Stewards noted its content.

The IHRB Veterinary Officer examined Tyre Kicker (FR), trained by Gavin Cromwell, at the request of the Raceday Stewards and reported the animal to be coughing and he was also found to be lame.

The Raceday Stewards reviewed the riders' first and second approach to the Starter, where the

riders were instructed to go back and take a turn on both occasions. Having reviewed the matter and consulted with the Senior Starter, Mr. J.R. Banahan, the Raceday Stewards were satisfied that the instruction to go back was for good reason and they were also satisfied that no riding offence had occurred.
